Parent information pack

PE Partner holiday club at Churwell

We are really looking forward to providing your children with a great time at our holiday clubs.

They might look a little different than normal, but we plan to have the same amount of fun and make sure all the kids have a great time.

Please can you read the following information so you know what we will be doing and the correct procedure for dropping your children off at the clubs and how to help us all maintain social distancing.

Being safe

All PE Partner coaches will be adhering to all Government guidance regards holiday clubs as it is, at the time of the club running.

We'll adopt the bubble system, (capped at 2 bubbles), operate physically distanced games and activities, with no contact sports.

Children will wash/sanitise their hands before and after each activity and before and after eating.

All equipment and the venue will be cleaned at during the day and at the end of the day.

If your child is unwell, please do not send them to the club, and advise PE Partner why they are not attending.

What to bring?

Please send your child in clothing to do sports indoors and outdoors

Please apply sun tan cream before your child attends the club if it is a warm day.

Please send your child with a pencil case, with, pens, pencils etc for when we are doing quizzes, colouring etc. There will be no sharing this equipment.

Please provide a packed lunch, some snacks and non fizzy drinks.

Arriving at Churwell primary

The clubs are running in the school lower building where the field is and there will be staggered start times KS1 at 09.00 and KS2 at 08.50am.

KS1 are in the Games room and KS2 are in the Jappa hall

There will be arrows and signs showing where parents need to go to register their child in.

There will be a hand sanitiser station prior to registration point with a notice to ask parents and children to use.

Registration point for KS1 children

KS1 registration is at 09.00am : Is at the small gate entrance to the lower building of the school, where the field is.

A PE Partner coach will be at the gate ready to sign your child in.

Once signed in your child will go and stand next to a cone leading up to the building.

There will be 2 metre spaces on the floor using cones/tape to maintain social distancing.

Please be patient at this time, we can only sign one child in at a time.

There are no parents allowed in the school.

Registration point for KS2 children

KS2 registration is at 08.50am : Is at the large gate in the lower building of the school, where the field is.

A PE Partner coach will be at the gate ready to sign your child.

Once signed in your child will go and stand next to a cone leading up to the building.

There will be 2 metre spaces on the floor using cones/tape to maintain social distancing.

Please be patient at this time, we can only sign one child in at a time.

There are no parents allowed in the school.

Exiting the venue after drop off

After dropping off your child at registration point, parents will leave maintaining social distancing and with no gatherings.

Collecting your child

This will be same point you registered the children in the morning and are staggered collection times. KS1 is at 3 20pm and KS2 is at 3 30pm.

Children will stand at a cone on the path. There will be 2 metre spaces on the floor using cones/tape to maintain social distancing.

PE Partner coach will come to the gate, ask who you are collecting, and ask the child to come over and be signed out.

Please be patient at this time, we can only sign one child out at a time

Please maintain social distancing at pick up time and no gatherings.

No parents allowed in school

Exiting the venue

After collecting your child at registration point, parents will leave maintaining social distancing and with no gatherings.
